9 Interpretation.

- (1) In this act, and in any amendments made by this Act in any other enactment, "Solomon Islands" means the territories which immediately before Independence Day constitute the Solomon Islands protectorate; and "the 1948 Act" means the MI British Nationality Act 1948.
