#### ORDERS AND DECISIONS UNDER SECTIONS 3, 4 AND 6

## *Hearing of representations*

- 4 (1) In the course of the hearing of oral representations the [<sup>F1</sup>lead enforcement authority] shall, at the request of the person affected, permit any other person (in addition to the person affected) to make representations on his behalf or to give evidence or to introduce documents for him.
  - (2) The [<sup>F2</sup>lead enforcement authority] shall not refuse to admit evidence solely on the grounds that it would not be admissible in a court of law.
