MISCELLANEOUS AND GENERAL

General

40 Repeals.

- (1) The enactments mentioned in Schedule 12 are repealed to the extent specified in the third column of that Schedule.
- (2) Part I of that Schedule has effect as from the day appointed by the Secretary of State for the purposes of section 5.
- (3) Part II of that Schedule has effect as from the day appointed by the Secretary of State under section 15(1), except for the repeal of the entry for the National Ports Council in Part II of Schedule 1 to the ^{M1}House of Commons Disqualification Act 1975 which comes into force on the Council ceasing to exist.
- (4) Part III of that Schedule so far as relates to—
 - (a) the ^{M2}Railway Fires Act (1905) Amendment Act 1923; and
 - (b) the ^{M3}Public Passenger Vehicles Act 1981,comes into force on the passing of this Act and otherwise comes into force on such day as the Secretary of State may appoint by order made by statutory instrument and different days may be so appointed for different purposes.
