36	Power to wind up the fund.

(2	2) On such day as is declared by the Secretary of State by order to be that on which the winding up was completed sections 32(1), (5), (6) and (7) and 33 of this Act shat cease to have effect, and as from that day subsections (2) and (4) of section 32 of the Act shall have effect as if—
	(a) all payments under those subsections fell to be defrayed out of mone provided by Parliament, instead of out of the Aviation Security Fund; and
	(b) the consent of the Treasury were required for all such payments.
