Functions of the Secretary of State

122 Provision of pocket money for in-patients in hospital.

- (1) [^{F1}Welsh Ministers may (in relation to Wales)] pay to persons who are receiving treatment as in-patients (whether liable to be detained or not) in [^{F2} special hospitals or other hospitals, being hospitals] wholly or mainly used for the treatment of persons suffering from mental disorder, such amounts as [^{F3}the Welsh Ministers think fit] in respect of [^{F4}those persons'] occasional personal expenses where it appears to [^{F5}the Welsh Ministers] that [^{F6}those persons] would otherwise be without resources to meet those expenses.
- (2) For the purposes of ^{F7}... [^{F8}the National Health Service (Wales) Act 2006], the making of payments under this section to persons for whom hospital services are provided under [^{F9}that Act] shall be treated as included among those services.
