SPECIAL CONTROL OF NAVIGATION, ETC.

PART III

SUPPLEMENTARY PROVISIONS

- 8 The Secretary of State may delegate—
 - (a) any of his powers under Part I of this Schedule; and
 - (b) the giving or withholding of any consent required or the taking of any other action he is authorised to take for the purposes of Part II of this Schedule;
 - to the harbour master or to any other person appointed by him for the purpose.
- Any consent given for the purposes of any provision of Part II of this Schedule by the Secretary of State or by any person exercising a power delegated for him by the Secretary of State in accordance with paragraph 8 above may be given subject to conditions.
- A person who without reasonable excuse contravenes any provision of Part II of this Schedule to fails to comply with any condition attached to a consent given for the purposes of any such provision shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding level 3 on the standard scale ^{FI}. . ..
