CHAPTER 10

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1984 (REPEALED 27.5.1997)

- 1 Application for planning permission etc. in anticipation of disposal of Crown land.
- 2 Tree preservation orders in anticipation of disposal of Crown land.
- 3 Control of development on Crown land.
- 4 Persons in occupation of land by virtue of a licence or contract.
- 5 Requirement of planning permission for continuance of use instituted by the Crown.
- 6 Interpretation and supplementary provisions.
- 7 Short title, commencement and extent.
