GENERAL PROVISIONS FOR TRAFFIC REGULATION

Outside Greater London

5 Contravention of traffic regulation order.

- (1) A person who contravenes a traffic regulation order, or who uses a vehicle, or causes or permits a vehicle to be used in contravention of a traffic regulation order, shall be guilty of an offence.
