Liabilities of associated bodies

Obligation to meet liabilities of associated bodies.

- (1) If a body corporate is linked by resolution with a building society or is a subsidiary of the society, then, subject to subsection (2) below, the building society is under an obligation by virtue of this section to discharge the liabilities of that associated body in so far as that body is unable to discharge them out of its own assets.
- (2) The obligation so imposed does not extend to the liabilities of the associated body to its members other than the building society with which it is associated.
- (3) Any expression used in this section and section 18 has the same meaning in this section as in that section.
