### Affiliation orders

- 6 (1) Neither section 17 of this Act nor any associated amendment or repeal shall affect, or affect the operation of any enactment in relation to—
  - (a) any affiliation order made under the <sup>MI</sup>Affiliation Proceedings Act 1957 which is in force immediately before the coming into force of that section; or
  - (b) any affiliation order made under that Act by virtue of paragraph 1 above.
  - (2) Any reference in this paragraph or paragraph 7 below to an affiliation order made under the Affiliation Proceedings Act 1957 includes a reference to—
    - (a) an affiliation order made, by virtue of section 44 of the <sup>M2</sup>National Assistance Act 1948, section 19 of the <sup>M3</sup>Supplementary Benefits Act 1976, section 49 or 50 of the <sup>M4</sup>Child Care Act 1980 or section 25 of the <sup>M5</sup>Social Security Act 1986; and
    - (b) any order made in relation to such an order.
