MISCELLANEOUS AND GENERAL

Interpretation

177 Adaptation of expressions for Scotland.

In the application of this Part to Scotland—

“account of profits” means accounting and payment of profits;

“accounts” means count, reckoning and payment;

“assignment” means assignation;

“costs” means expenses;

“defendant” means defender;

“delivery up” means delivery;

“estoppel” means personal bar;

“injunction” means interdict;

“interlocutory relief” means interim remedy; and

“plaintiff” means pursuer.
