ACTS PERMITTED IN RELATION TO COPYRIGHT WORKS

Miscellaneous: broadcasts ^{F1}...

70 Recording for purposes of time-shifting.

- [^{F1}(1)] The making [^{F2} in domestic premises] for private and domestic use of a recording of a broadcast ^{F3}... solely for the purpose of enabling it to be viewed or listened to at a more convenient time does not infringe any copyright in the broadcast ^{F3}... or in any work included in it.
- [^{F4}(2) Where a copy which would otherwise be an infringing copy is made in accordance with this section but is subsequently dealt with—
 - (a) it shall be treated as an infringing copy for the purposes of that dealing; and
 - (b) if that dealing infringes copyright, it shall be treated as an infringing copy for all subsequent purposes.
 - (3) In subsection (2), "dealt with" means sold or let for hire, offered or exposed for sale or hire or communicated to the public.]
