



# Computer Misuse Act 1990

## 1990 CHAPTER 18

### *Jurisdiction*

#### **9 British citizenship immaterial.**

- (1) [<sup>F1</sup>Except as provided by section 5(1A),]In any proceedings brought in England and Wales in respect of any offence to which this section applies it is immaterial to guilt whether or not the accused was a British citizen at the time of any act, omission or other event proof of which is required for conviction of the offence.
- (2) This section applies to the following offences—
  - (a) any [<sup>F2</sup>offence under [<sup>F3</sup>this Act]] ;
  - <sup>F4</sup>(b) .....
  - (c) any attempt to commit an offence under [<sup>F5</sup>this Act]; and
  - (d) <sup>F6</sup> .....
