1990 CHAPTER 36

An Act to make provision as to the law applicable to contractual obligations in the case of conflict of laws. [26th July 1990]

Be it enacted by the Queen's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and Commons, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—
