Provision for discharge of functions

- 1 (1) The [FISecretary of State] may give general directions concerning the discharge of the functions of the Legal Services Ombudsman.
 - (2) Any such directions shall be published by the [F1Secretary of State] in such manner as appears to him to be appropriate.
