#### AMENDMENTS OF PROVISIONS RELATING TO POWERS OF COUNCIL ETC.

#### *Inadequate professional services: compensation*

- 16 (1) The amount specified in a direction by virtue of paragraph 15(1)(c) shall not exceed [<sup>F1</sup>£5,000].
- (2) The [<sup>F2</sup>Secretary of State] may by order made by statutory instrument amend subparagraph (1) by substituting for the sum of £1,000 such other sum as he considers appropriate.
- (3) Before making any such order the [<sup>F2</sup>Secretary of State] shall consult the Council.
- (4) Any statutory instrument made under this paragraph shall be subject to annulment in pursuance of a resolution of either House of Parliament.
