SCHEDULE

ENFORCEMENT

Disclosure of information

- 7 (1) If a person discloses to another any information obtained by him by virtue of this Schedule he shall be guilty of an offence unless the disclosure was made—
- (a) in or for the purpose of the performance by him or any other person of any function under this Act, or
 - (b) for a purpose specified in section 38(2)(a), (b) or (c) of the ^{M1}Consumer Protection Act 1987.
- (2) A person guilty of an offence under sub-paragraph (1) above shall be liable—
- (a) on summary conviction, to a fine not exceeding the statutory maximum, and
 - (b) on conviction on indictment, to a fine.
