

Forestry Act 1991

1991 CHAPTER 43

An Act to increase from nine to twelve the maximum number of members of a regional advisory committee maintained under section 37 of the Forestry Act 1967. [25th July 1991]

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and Commons, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. In subsection (3) of section 38 of the Forestry Act 1967 (composition of regional advisory committees), for the word "nine" there shall be substituted the word "twelve".

Composition of regional advisory committees.

- 2.—(1) This Act may be cited as the Forestry Act 1991.
- (2) This Act shall come into force at the end of the period of two months beginning with the date on which it is passed.
 - (3) This Act shall not extend to Northern Ireland.
