

Still-Birth (Definition) Act 1992

1992 CHAPTER 29

1 Meaning of "still-born child", etc.

- (1) In section 12 of the MIBirths and Deaths Registration Act 1926 (definitions) and section 41 of the MIBirths and Deaths Registration Act 1953 (interpretation), in the provisions which relate to the meaning of "still-born child" for the words "twenty-eighth week", in both places where they occur, there shall be substituted "twenty-fourth week".
- (2) In section 56(1) of the M3 Registration of Births, Deaths and Marriages (Scotland) Act 1965 (interpretation) in the definition of "still-born child" for the words "twenty-eighth week" there shall be substituted "twenty-fourth week".
