



Statute Law (Repeals) Act 1993

1993 CHAPTER 50

4 Short title and commencement.

- (1) This Act may be cited as the Statute Law (Repeals) Act 1993.
- (2) The repeal by this Act of—
 - (a) paragraph 5 of Schedule 2 to the ^{M1}National Loans Act 1939,
 - (b) paragraph 10 of Schedule 1 to the ^{M2}Bank of England Act 1946, and
 - (c) section 33(8) of the ^{M3}Coal Industry Nationalisation Act 1946,shall have effect, so far as relating to stock registered in the National Savings Stock Register, on the coming into force of the first regulations made by virtue of section 3(1) (bb) of the ^{M4}National Debt Act 1972.
- (3) The repeal by this Act of the ^{M5}Shipbuilding (Redundancy Payments) Act 1978 and section 1 of the ^{M6}Shipbuilding Act 1985 shall come into force on such day as the Lord Chancellor may by order made by statutory instrument appoint.
