1994 CHAPTER 16

2 Consequential amendments and repeals.

- (1) In section 105(4)(b) of the MINational Health Service (Scotland) Act 1978 (procedure as respects orders), the words "and 102(2)" are hereby repealed.
- (2) In section 108(1) of that Act (interpretation), for the definition of "state hospital" there shall be substituted the following—

""state hospital" has the meaning indicated in section 102(2);".

(3) Sections 90 and 91(1) of the M2 Mental Health (Scotland) Act 1984 are hereby repealed.
