PROVISIONS SUPPLEMENTING SECTION 1

Extent Information

Normal day-to-day activities

- 4 ^[F1](1) An impairment is to be taken to affect the ability of the person concerned to carry out normal day-to-day activities only if it affects one of the following—
- (a) mobility;
 - (b) manual dexterity;
 - (c) physical co-ordination;
 - (d) continence;
 - (e) ability to lift, carry or otherwise move everyday objects;
 - (f) speech, hearing or eyesight;
 - (g) memory or ability to concentrate, learn or understand; or
 - (h) perception of the risk of physical danger.
- ^[F2](i) taking part in normal social interaction; or
- (j) forming social relationships]
- (2) Regulations may prescribe—
- (a) circumstances in which an impairment which does not have an effect falling within sub-paragraph (1) is to be taken to affect the ability of the person concerned to carry out normal day-to-day activities;
 - (b) circumstances in which an impairment which has an effect falling within sub-paragraph (1) is to be taken not to affect the ability of the person concerned to carry out normal day-to-day activities.]

Extent Information

- E1** Following the repeal of this Act for E.W.S. by the Equality Act 2010, this provision now extends to Northern Ireland only
