CENTRAL SUPERVISION, DIRECTION AND FACILITIES

Functions of Secretary of State

48 Grants for expenditure on safeguarding national security.

- (1) The Secretary of State may make grants in respect of expenditure incurred (or to be incurred) for police purposes [FI by local policing bodies in connection with safeguarding national security].
- (2) Grants under this section may be made either unconditionally or subject to conditions.
- (3) The Secretary of State shall exercise his powers under this section only with the approval of the Treasury.
- [F2(4) Any grant [F3 under subsection (1) in respect of expenditure incurred (or to be incurred) by the Mayor's Office for Policing and Crime] shall be paid to the Greater London Authority.
 - (5) Where the Greater London Authority receives a grant under this section, it shall forthwith account for the grant to the [F4Mayor's Office for Policing and Crime] and pay it over to [F5that Office].]
