



Northern Ireland (Emergency Provisions) Act 1996

1996 CHAPTER 22

An Act to re-enact, with omissions and amendments, the Northern Ireland (Emergency Provisions) Act 1991; and for connected purposes. [17th June 1996]

Be it enacted by the Queen's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and Commons, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Modifications etc. (not altering text)

- C1** Act: temporary provisions of the Act (as defined in s. 62(2)) except s. 36, Sch. 3 to continue in force for a period of twelve months beginning with 16.6.1997 by [S.I. 1997/1114, art. 3](#)
- C2** Act: temporary provisions (as defined in s. 62(2)) to continue in force for a period of twelve months beginning with 16.6.1999 by [S.I. 1999/1709, art. 3](#)
