

# **Energy Conservation Act 1996**

#### **1996 CHAPTER 38**

#### 2 Citation and commencement.

- (1) This Act may be cited as the Energy Conservation Act 1996.
- (2) This Act shall come into force on such day as the Secretary of State may, by order made by statutory instrument, appoint; and different days may be appointed for different purposes and different areas.
- (3) The Secretary of State may by order under subsection (2) make such transitional provision as appears to him to be appropriate.
  - He may, in particular, make such adaptations of sections 2 to 4 of the <sup>M1</sup>Home Energy Conservation Act 1995 as are necessary to enable an energy conservation authority to prepare a separate report under section 2 on houses in multiple occupation or houseboats.
- (4) In the application of this section to Northern Ireland—
  - (a) references to the Secretary of State shall be construed as references to the Department of the Environment for Northern Ireland;
  - (b) the reference to an order made by statutory instrument shall be construed as a reference to an order which is a statutory rule for the purposes of the M2Statutory Rules (Northern Ireland) Order 1979.
