#### SUPPLEMENTARY

#### 23 Other interpretation provisions.

- (1) In this Act “purchaser” has the same meaning as in Part I of the <sup>M1</sup>Law of Property Act 1925.
- (2) Subject to that, where an expression used in this Act is given a meaning by the Law of Property Act 1925 it has the same meaning as in that Act unless the context otherwise requires.
- (3) In this Act “the court” means—
  - (a) the High Court, or
  - (b) [<sup>F1</sup>the county court].
