#### SUPPLEMENTARY

## Intervention by Secretary of State

- 30 (1) The [<sup>F1</sup>Secretary of State] may by directions require a planning authority to refer any request for approval under Part II or III of this Schedule to [<sup>F2</sup>him].
  - (2) In determining a request referred to [<sup>F2</sup>him] under this paragraph, the [<sup>F1</sup>Secretary of State] shall have the same powers as the authority making the reference.
  - (3) The determination by the [<sup>F1</sup>Secretary of State] of a request referred to [<sup>F2</sup>him] under this paragraph shall be final.
  - (4) Directions under this paragraph may—
    - (a) be given in relation to a specified request or requests of a specified description, and
    - (b) cancel or vary previous directions under this paragraph.
