

# Protection from Harassment Act 1997

### **1997 CHAPTER 40**

#### England and Wales

#### 2 Offence of harassment.

- (1) A person who pursues a course of conduct in breach of [FI section 1(1) or (1A)] is guilty of an offence.
- (2) A person guilty of an offence under this section is liable on summary conviction to imprisonment for a term not exceeding six months, or a fine not exceeding level 5 on the standard scale, or both.
