##### *Intimation of devolution issue*

- 23 Intimation of any devolution issue which arises in any proceedings before a court or tribunal shall be given to the Advocate General for Scotland [<sup>F1</sup>and the Attorney General for Northern Ireland] (unless the person to whom the intimation would be given is a party to the proceedings).
