Supplementary

11 Interpretation.

(1) In this Act—

“land” has the same meaning as in the ^{M1}Trustee Act 1925, and

“enduring power” has the same meaning as in the ^{M2}Enduring Powers of Attorney Act 1985.

(2) References in this Act to the creation of a power of attorney are to the execution by the donor of the instrument creating it.

13 Commencement, extent and short title.

(1) The preceding provisions of this Act shall come into force on such day as the Lord Chancellor may by order made by statutory instrument appoint.

(2) This Act extends to England and Wales only.

(3) This Act may be cited as the Trustee Delegation Act 1999.
