Court proceedings

73 Power to allow children to attend criminal proceedings.

- (1) In section 36 of the ^{M1}Children and Young Persons Act 1933 (child not to be present at criminal trial except where required as witness or otherwise for the purposes of justice), after “justice” insert “ or while the court consents to his presence ”.
- (2) In section 50(1) of the ^{M2}Criminal Procedure (Scotland) Act 1995 (child not to be present at criminal proceedings unless required as witness or otherwise for the purposes of justice), after “justice” insert “ or the court consents to his presence ”.
