- (4) Subsection (5) applies where the postage chargeable by a [F2postal operator] in connection with the provision of [F3postal services] on a postal packet consisting of parliamentary proceedings has not been prepaid by the sender or has been insufficiently prepaid by him.
- (5) No sum exceeding the amount of the postage or (as the case may be) the deficiency may be recovered by the [F4postal operator] (whether from the sender or the addressee).
- (6) In this section "parliamentary proceedings" means proceedings of either House of Parliament, the Scottish Parliament, the National Assembly for Wales or the Northern Ireland Assembly.
