## **2000 CHAPTER 36**

#### PART I

#### ACCESS TO INFORMATION HELD BY PUBLIC AUTHORITIES

## Right to information

#### **8** Request for information.

- (1) In this Act any reference to a "request for information" is a reference to such a request which—
  - (a) is in writing,
  - (b) states the name of the applicant and an address for correspondence, and
  - (c) describes the information requested.
- (2) For the purposes of subsection (1)(a), a request is to be treated as made in writing where the text of the request—
  - (a) is transmitted by electronic means,
  - (b) is received in legible form, and
  - (c) is capable of being used for subsequent reference.
