COMMUNITY INTEREST COMPANIES

Change of status

56 Becoming [^{F1}a registered society]

- (1) Unless regulations make provision to the contrary, a community interest company may not convert itself into a registered society under [^{F2}section 115 of the Co-operative and Community Benefit Societies Act 2014][^{F3}or section 62 of the Industrial and Provident Societies Act (Northern Ireland) 1969].
- (2) If regulations make provision allowing the conversion of community interest companies under that section they may include provision modifying that section in its application by virtue of the regulations.
