Application

- 42 (1) A society may apply to the relevant local authority for registration under this Part.
- (2) An application under this paragraph—

 - (c) must contain such other information, and be accompanied by such documents, as may be prescribed, and
 - (d) must be accompanied by the prescribed fee.
