  - for the words from "is incapable" to "affairs" substitute " ("P") lacks (a) capacity (within the meaning of the Mental Capacity Act 2005) in relation to the provisions of the order ",
  - (b) for "that person under Part VIII of that Act" substitute "P under that Act",
  - for the words from "such persons" to the end substitute " such person ("D") (c) as it may direct ", and
  - at the end insert— (d)
    - "(2) In carrying out any functions of his in relation to an order made under subsection (1), D must act in P's best interests (within the meaning of that Act).".
