SCHEDULE 1

THE CARE QUALITY COMMISSION

Employees

- 5 ^{F1}(1)
- (2) The Commission may appoint [^{F2} such employees (in addition to the executive members appointed by the non-executive members)] as it considers appropriate.
- (3) Employees of the Commission are to be appointed on such terms and conditions as the Commission may determine.
- (4) Without prejudice to its other powers, the Commission may pay, or make provision for the payment of—
- (a) pensions, allowances and gratuities, or
 - (b) compensation for loss of employment or reduction of remuneration, to or in respect of its employees.
- [^{F3}(5) Before making a determination as to remuneration, pensions, allowances or gratuities for the purposes of sub-paragraph (3) or (4), the Commission must obtain the approval of the Secretary of State to its policy on that matter.]
