- 2 (1) The Secretary of State may, for purposes connected with Crossrail, make schemes for the transfer of property, rights and liabilities—
- (a) from the Greater London Authority <sup>F2</sup>... or Transport for London, or
  - (b) from a body corporate which is a wholly owned subsidiary of the Greater London Authority <sup>F3</sup>... or Transport for London,
- to any person, including the Secretary of State.
- (2) The power conferred by sub-paragraph (1) shall be exercisable only with the consent of the transferor.
