Section 81: Additional grounds for refusing an application to be registered

336. Section 81 amends the arrangements governing the CRB to extend the provision determining the grounds on which the CRB can refuse to register an organisation as a "Registered Body" (that is, a body responsible for the processing and the countersignature of applications for criminal record certificates) to include the power to refuse to register an organisation that has previously been removed from the register as a result of a breach of the CRB Conditions of Registration.
