

Defamation Act 2013

2013 CHAPTER 26

General provisions

17 Short title, extent and commencement

- (1) This Act may be cited as the Defamation Act 2013.
- (2) ^{F1}...This Act extends to England and Wales only.
- - (4) Subject to [^{F3}subsection] (6), the provisions of this Act come into force on such day as the Secretary of State may by order made by statutory instrument appoint.
- - (6) Section 15, subsections (4) to (8) of section 16 and this section come into force on the day on which this Act is passed.
