



Dogs Act 1906

1906 CHAPTER 32 6 Edw 7

6 Burying of carcases.

Any person who shall knowingly and without reasonable excuse permit the carcase of any head of cattle belonging to him [^{F1}or under his control] to remain unburied in a field or other place to which dogs can gain access shall be liable on conviction under the Summary Jurisdiction Acts to a fine not exceeding [^{F2}level 1 on the standard scale].
