



# Dogs Act 1906

1906 CHAPTER 32 6 Edw 7

## <sup>F1</sup>[<sup>F2</sup>6] **Burying of carcasses.**

Any person who shall knowingly and without reasonable excuse permit the carcase of any head of cattle belonging to him [<sup>F3</sup>or under his control] to remain unburied in a field or other place to which dogs can gain access shall be liable on conviction under the Summary Jurisdiction Acts to a fine not exceeding [<sup>F4</sup>level 1 on the standard scale].]
