REGULATIONS AND WARRANTS

82 Regulations and warrants

- (1) The Treasury may, by warrant, on the representation of the Postmaster-General, make regulations with respect to any matter which is authorised or required by this Act to be effected by Post Office regulations.
- (2) All Post Office regulations shall be laid as soon as may be before both Houses of Parliament, and a notice of the regulations having been made, and of the place where copies of them can be purchased, shall be published in the London Gazette.

83 Signature of Treasury warrants, consents, &c

Any warrant of the Treasury under this Act may be signified in manner provided by the Treasury Instruments (Signature) Act, 1849, and any order, consent, authority, or direction of the Treasury (not being a warrant) under this Act may be signified either in manner provided by that Act or under the hand of one of their secretaries or assistant secretaries.
