



# Emergency Laws (Repeal) Act 1959

1959 CHAPTER 19 7 and 8 Eliz 2

## 10 Short title, duration and repeals.

- (1) This Act may be cited as the Emergency Laws (Repeal) Act 1959.
- (2) The provisions of this Act, other than sections . . . <sup>F1</sup> six therefore and this section, shall continue in force only until the expiration of the thirty-first day of December, nineteen hundred and sixty-four, and shall then expire; and [<sup>F2</sup>sections sixteen (1) and seventeen (2)(a) of the <sup>M1</sup>Interpretation Act 1978], shall apply upon the expiration of those provisions as if those provisions had then been repealed.
