28 Orders and regulations.

- (1) Any order made under any provision of this Act may be varied or revoked by a subsequent order made thereunder.

- (3) Any order made under any . . . ^{F2} provision of this Act and any regulations made under section one thereof shall be made by statutory instrument which shall be subject to annulment in pursuance of a resolution of either House of Parliament.
