



House of Commons (Disqualifications) Act 1801

1801 CHAPTER 52

II All Persons disabled from sitting in Irish Parliaments, shall he disabled from sitting for *Ireland*.

And be it further enacted, That from and after the passing of this Act, all Persons disabled from or incapable of being elected, or sitting and voting in the House of Commons of any Parliament of *Ireland*, shall be disabled from and be incapable of being elected, or sitting and voting in the House of Commons of any Parliament of the United Kingdom, as Knights, Citizens, or Burgesses, for any County, City, Borough, Town, or Place, in that Part of the United Kingdom called *Ireland*.
