CHAPTER 128

REGIMENTAL ACCOUNTS ACT 1808 (REPEALED 8.11.1995)

- [1] So much of recited Act as requires the annual accounts of every regiment to be settled by the Secretary at War, and requires certificates of the charges allowed to be transmitted to the paymaster of the forces, repealed.
- 2 His Majesty may make regulations for the speedy settlement of accounts of regimental expenditures.
- 3 Balances due from agents, &c. not paid within a month after demand to be deemed a debt to His Majesty upon record.
