CHAPTER 128

REGIMENTAL ACCOUNTS ACT 1808

So much of recited Act as requires the, Annual Accounts of every Regiment to be settled by the Secretary at War, and requires Certificates of the Charges allowed to be tranfmitted to the Paymaster of the Forces, repealed.

- II His Majesty may make Regulations for the speedy Settlement of Regimental Expenditures
- III Balances due from Agents, &c. not paid within a Month after Demand, to be deemed a Debt to His Majesty upon Record.
