1809 CHAPTER 126

VI Inflicting a Penalty on Persons advertising or publishing the Names of Brokers or Agents.

And be it further enacted, That if any Person or Persons shall advertise or publish, or cause or procure to be advertised or in any Manner published any House, Room, Office, or Place to have been or to be opened, set up, or kept for any of the Purposes aforesaid, or advertise or publish, or cause or procure to be advertised or published, the Name or Names of any Person or Persons as Broker or Brokers, Agent or Agents, Solicitor or Solicitors for any of the Purposes aforesaid, or print or cause or procure or permit or suffer to be printed or advertised any Advertisement or Advertisements, Proposal or Proposals for any of the Purposes aforesaid, then and in such Case such Person or Persons shall forfeit for every such Offence the Sum of Fifty Pounds, to be sued for, levied, or recovered in any of His Majesty's Courts of Record at *Westminster*, as to all Offences Committed in *England*, or at *Dublin* as to Offences committed in *Ireland*, or in His Majesty's Courts in *Scotland* as to Offences committed in *Scotland* respectively and the Whole of every such Penalty shall go to the Person who shall sue for the same, with full Costs of Suit.
