1812 CHAPTER 161

XVI Act not to infringe any Rights under Letters Patent.

Provided always, and it is hereby declared, That nothing in this Act. contained shall extend or be deemed or construed to extend, to defeat, alter, or infringe all or any of the Rights, Privileges, or Advantages which may be enjoyed or claimed under any Letters Patent granted by His said Majesty, His Ancestors, or Predecessors, of any Office, Bailiwick, Walk, or Lodge, within any of the said Forests.
